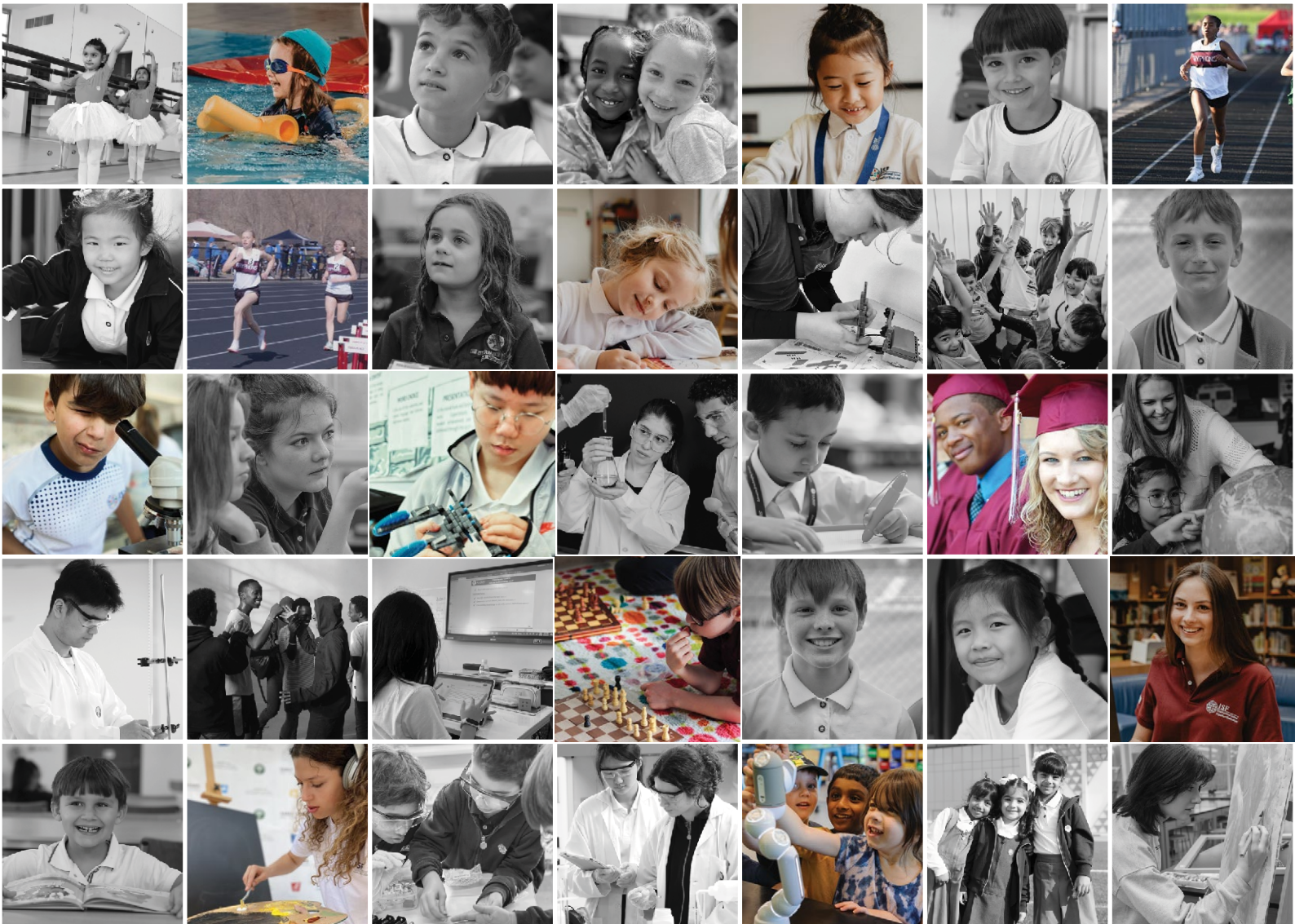

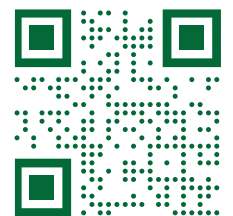

Mother's Day

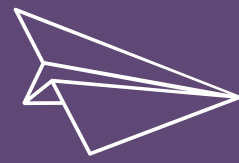
